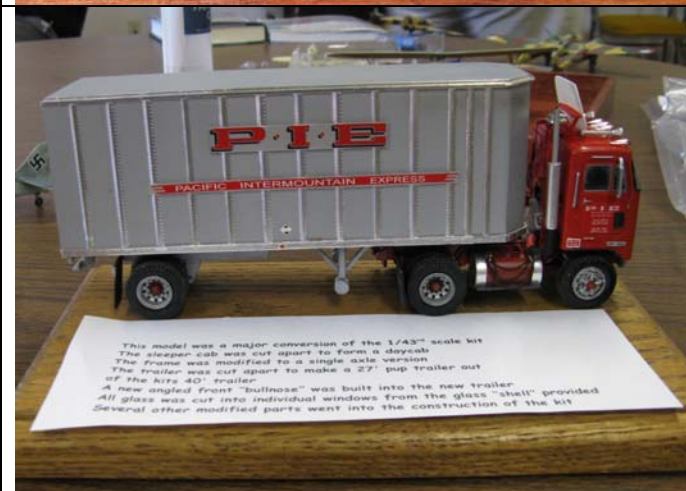

This model was a major conversion of the 1/43" scale kit
The sleeper cab was cut apart to form a daycab
The frame was modified to a single axle version
The trailer was cut apart to make a 27' pup trailer out
of the kits 40' trailer
A new angled front "bullnose" was built into the new trailer
All glass was cut into individual windows from the glass "shell" provided
Several other modified parts went into the construction of the kit
