

Aviation Museum of Kentucky by Tom Bebout

Ninety miles south of Cincinnati is *The Aviation Museum of Kentucky* which is at the Lexington Bluegrass Airport. Incorporated in 1981 and by 1984 the Kentucky General Assembly designated the museum as the Commonwealth's official Aviation Hall of Fame. Not only recognizing citizens of the state for their contributions to aviation, but another of their missions is to educate young people about aviation and possible careers in the field of aviation.

Consequently each year they offer an Aviation Summer Camp for 10 to 15 year old children. The camp gives the kids a chance to study flight with professional instructors and then to go aloft with licensed instructors. On display are restored barnstormers, historic warbirds, and lots of memorabilia. A rare find at the museum is a Crosley C-4 Moonbeam bi-plane, the only one known to exist today. I encourage all to drop by for a visit since it's so close and have a look around.


July 2010 - CSM Picnic
