It was a really good turnout with more than 75 vendor tables plus 75 modelers entered 320 contest entries, and by counting actual models, since some were multiple models, we had upwards of 350 models in all. The 2015 Nats in Columbus had 2412 models entered so our contest is 1/8 as large (the all-time high was the 2005 Atlanta Nats with 3020).

Quite a great contest we threw, in my opinion. The “Best Of’s” are listed here with the Grand Prize Best in Show going to *Michael Fox* with his 1/35 scale M1126 Stryker buildup. The CSM owes a big ‘thank you’ to all who volunteered to help, including set-up and teardown, judging, registration, raffles, Make ‘n Take and for just showing up! ☺ Hope to see all of you next year!!!
