oct. 8th 1944 - US forces make their first significant advance in Germanys Huertgen forest.

oct.11th 1941- Soviet T-34 tanks go into action against the Germans for the first time.

oct.14th 1939 - U-47commanded by Gunther Prien, sinks British battleship Royal Oak at Scapa Flow.

oct.14th 1943 - u.s. bombers attack ball bearing plants at Schweinfurt, Germany suffering heavy losses.

oct.17th 1943 - "Pappy" Boyington and VMF-214 shoot down 20 enemy aircraft over Kahili, without loss of a single plane.

oct.23rd 1944 - the battle of Leyte Gulf, the largest naval battle in history, begins. It ends in a US victory 3 days later.

oct. 31st 1941- the destroyer USS Reuben James is sunk by U-552, the 'Red Devil', commanded by Erich Topp. Pappy Boyington USMC ace, and commander of the Black Sheep squadron, was shot down over Rabual, during a fighter sweep. After his capture, he was held as a "captive" as opposed to a POW since the Japanese didn't report his captivity to the international Red Cross. He was awarded the medal of honor; it was thought posthumously. On his return he was presented the M.O.H. by President Truman. On the citation was a description of one of his most daring exploits. It read as follows. " Resolute in his efforts to inflict crippling damage on the enemy, Major Boyington led a formation of 26 fighters over Kahili, and personally circled the airdrome, where 60 hostile planes were grounded, boldly challenged the Japanese to send up planes. Under his brilliant command, our fighters shot down twenty enemy aircraft without the loss of a single ship."

Oct 11th is our very own Cincinnati Scale Modelers – a very cool annual fall contest, and where else would you have a chance to see "Pappy's" Corsair, or Topp's U- boat, or maybe an early T-34? Plus lots of other scale tributes to history and our heroes. Hope you have fun, and happy modeling until next month

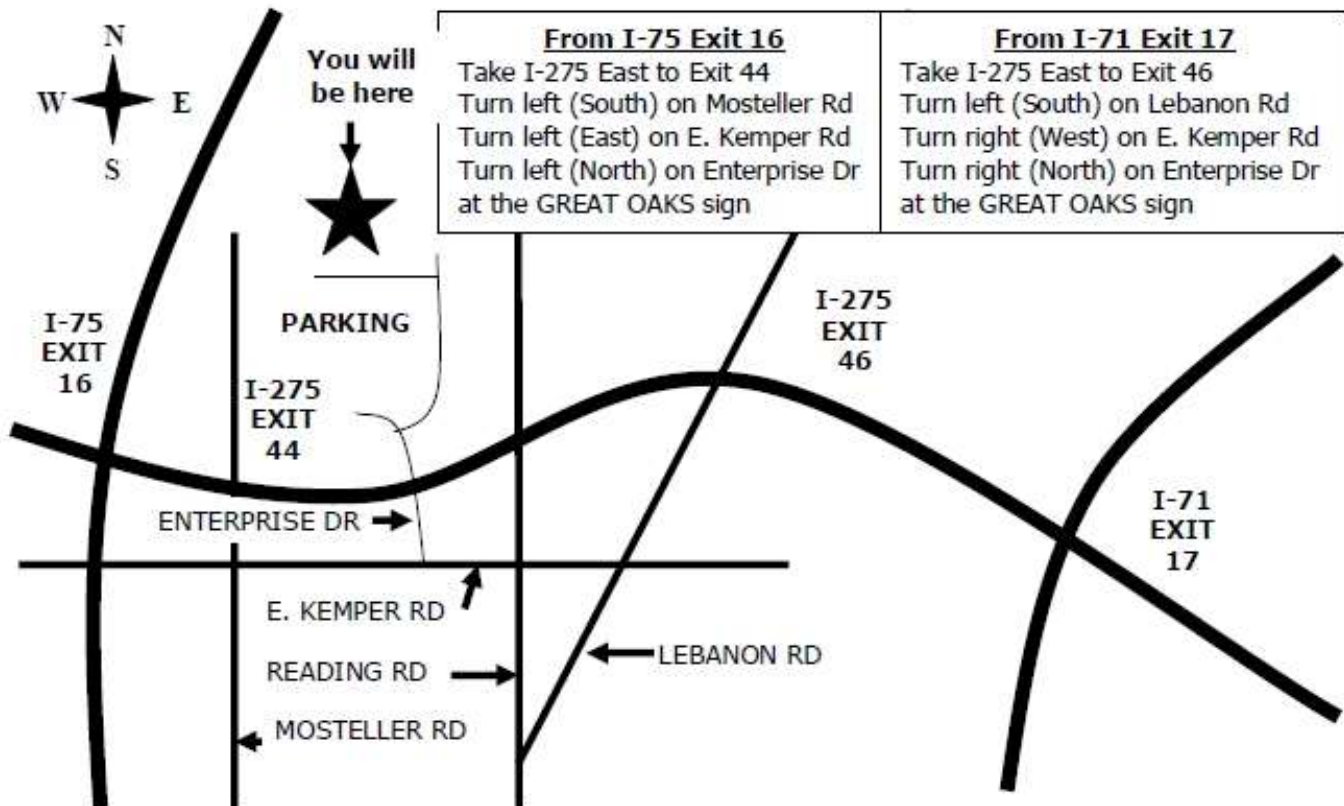
