September 3rd 1943 -Italy surrenders to the allies.

September 8th 1944 - The first V-2 rockets strike London.

September 12th 1943 - German airborne troops rescue Italian dictator Benito Mussolini from captivity by the Italian resistance.

This September marks the 69th anniversary of the end of the second world war, now in my most humble opinion our greatest commanding general during the conflict was Douglas MacArthur, (as I'm sure my grandmother would agree since she named my father Douglas MacArthur, dad was born June '42). I know some in the club may disagree, and this could be a fun little debate at our next meeting, but for me the best general will always be MacArthur.

Immediately after the Japanese delegation left the Missouri, MacArthur broadcast a moving message to the American people, I would like to share with you the last paragraph of that message.

"And so, my fellow countrymen, today I report to you, that your sons and daughters have served you well and faithfully with the calm, deliberate, determined fighting spirit of the American soldier and sailor, based upon a tradition of historical trait, as against the fanaticism of an enemy supported only by mythological fiction. Their spiritual strength and power has brought us through to victory. They are homeward bound - take care of them."

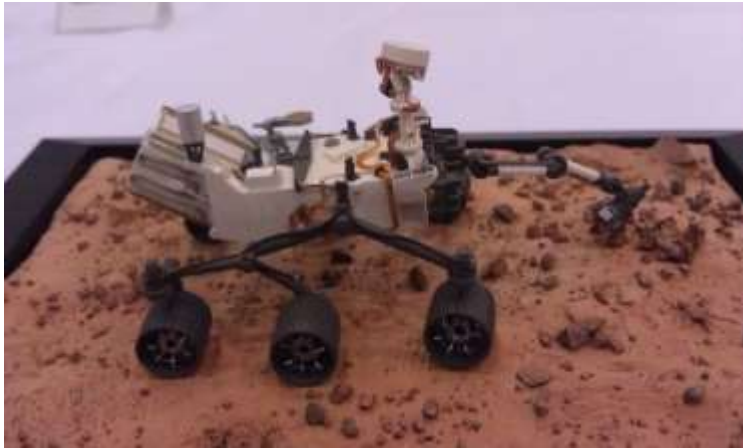






2014 IPMS/USA National Convention by Rob Schorry
